MAKE THE BASKET AND GET IT TO US.

All items should be **new** and **unused**.

Remove all price tags.

Books that are included in a basket will need to be reviewed.

Baskets need to be in a large/jumbo, **clear**, cellophane bags (from Michael's, etc.)

Tie the bags closed with bows, ribbons, curl, or twine. Make it look "cute"!

Paper shreds/tissue paper are great in the bottom of the baskets to fill empty spaces.

Make a **simple** list of each item in the basket and **email or turn it in to us when you return your basket. We will make uniform signs for them.**

Baskets can be turned in to RMC beginning July 20 through August 25,

including the list of items for us to make signs.

Individual items will be accepted also, but need to be received no later than August 18 by the retreat team.
